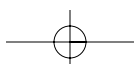

What does the chapter certification committee do? It runs so smooth most of the time, I had to stop and think what we are responsible for.

Our primary objectives are to provide the chapter a certification study course, and exam site for those attempting to become certified.

CSI has four outstanding programs with CDT, CCS, CCCA, and CCPR. The chapter has had a study course set up for many years, of which the last 7 or so have been at HACC. The class is part of a three year program in Construction Technology, and is required for graduation. A typical year yields 6-8 HACC students, and about the same people taking it as a non-credit class.

The committee typically consists of 7-9 certified instructors who are assigned a portion of the PRM to present. Last year the class was totally revamped to accommodate the new CSI Project Resource Manual (PRM). It was a necessary task to prepare candidate for the certification exams. The PRM has many changes that reflect current trends in the construction industry. Those of you still using the MOP should consider upgrading. Call me to order your PRM.

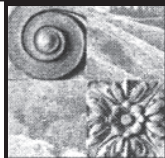

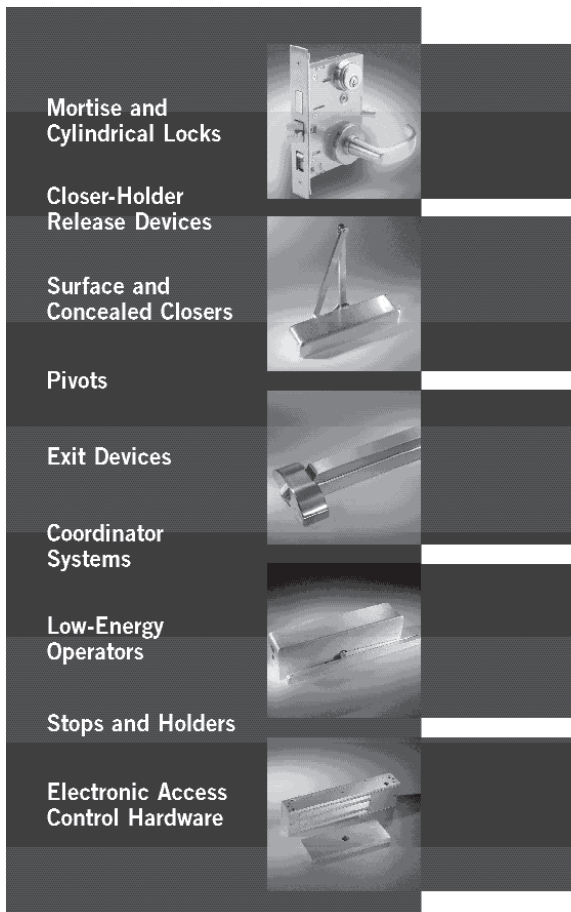
